1. Submit the **completed Program Application** (with Biographical Section) and, if applicable, the **Loan/Scholarship Application** to: **Rudolf Steiner College, Admissions Office, 9200 Fair Oaks Blvd., Fair Oaks, CA 95628** or fax: **916-961-8731**
2. Submit a **\$50 Application Fee** (non-refundable) with your application (\$70 if you are applying within 30 days of the program). Include a **\$15 Credit Check Fee** if you are applying for Financial Assistance.
3. **MA applicants:** Applicants applying to for an MA in Waldorf Education (Residential and Hybrid programs ONLY in 2011) are required to have three **letters of recommendation** – use college form found online at *www.steinercollege.edu*.
4. Request **official transcripts from the colleges you listed on this application** and have them mailed to: Rudolf Steiner College, Admissions Office at the address above. Photocopies are not acceptable.  
Note: NO transcripts are required for Waldorf Administration or LifeWays Programs.  
MA students in Waldorf Education are required to have a BA or BS from an accredited college. See *MA requirements in online Catalogue*. International transcripts must be in English and evaluated by a US educational research service for the equivalent US accredited degree.
5. When your required paperwork is complete, it is reviewed by the Program Director. You will be notified by Admissions of your status in the program or if the Program Director requests an interview or requires letters of recommendation. We contact people via email.
6. Financial Aid requests will be processed upon your acceptance into a program.
7. **To attend classes, all RSC contracts sent to you must be signed, dated, and received by RSC along with the exact amount due at least 10 business days before the first class or late fees will be applied.**
